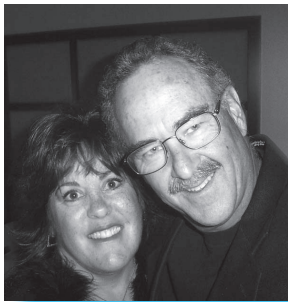


Making Impressions for Eternity

Kevin & Debbie Eggleston of El Cajon, CA are giving nine months of this year to direct and coordinate the Impression Team (IT) program in France. That's an enormous commitment of their resources, talents and energy - as well as a major sacrifice of time they'd like to spend with

their children, family, friends and church in CA!

As they considered the needs in France, Kevin brought to our attention the need for a more suitable vehicle for transporting the team members. The two existing vehicles are over 10 years old, with the cost of needed repairs totalling more than their value.



Consequently, donors have come forward with a gift of \$24,000 to be used as a **Matching Grant for the purchase of a 9-passenger van, as well as another smaller vehicle** for use by the staff.

Tyran Laws is our U.S. IT Coordinator, while at the same time working on his Master's at Wheaton College and serving as Youth Pastor in his church. No doubt, Tyran could earn a higher salary elsewhere, but he's chosen to *make an impression for eternity* by working for BLF. Largely through his efforts, teams are recruited to serve in France. In fact, he even joined a team



last October and will be leading his own team later this year.

Our Impression Team program has regained much of it's former energy and 'health', for which we are so grateful! Each team member makes a very

definite *impression for eternity* whether they're working in the printshop shrinkwrapping Christian books, putting gospel tracts in mailboxes, or working on a renovation project. In March, the team from El Cajon, CA plans to complete the renovation of the missionary housing apartment - what a blessing it will be to have a refurbished 'home' for our missionary staff!
